- The Forum will have two strategic thematic areas of focus on realizing the benefits and addressing the challenges of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and climate change. The discussions will be mainstreamed across the programme.
- Panels will be balanced by expertise, region, gender and age.
- Official sessions will be fully in person. Side events can be either fully in-person, hybrid or fully online.
- Thematic sessions would relate to the theme of the 2024 HLPF and consider how STI can contribute to progress in the SDGs under review at the HLPF this year including SDGs 1 no poverty, 2 zero hunger, 13 climate action, 16 peace, justice, and strong institutions, and 17 partnerships and means of implementation. Additionally, the thematic sessions may consider cross-cutting issues such as gender and STI, emerging and digital technologies, STI roadmaps, and youth. The context of the upcoming fourth International Conference on Small Island Developing States (SIDS4), the third UN Conference on Land Locked Developing Countries, and the Summit of the Future in addition to other high-level events may also inform the focus of thematic sessions.
- Exhibitions, special events and side events can be organized during the STI Forum to further draw attention to important thematic topics.
