

Strengthening VNR/VLR Reporting through Digital Platforms: The case of the ECA Integrated Planning and Reporting Tool

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Voluntary National/Local Review

- VNRs/VLRs are intended to track progress in implementing the 2030 Agenda, including the SDGs and targets, in all countries, in a manner that respects their universal and integrated nature and all dimensions of sustainable development
- The VNR handbook calls on countries to align with the SDGs in the following areas:
- National vision
- National and sub-national Development Plans
- Financing frameworks
- Sectoral policies

Voluntary National/Local Review

- The relevance of tracking is enhanced if it provides insights into the underlying reasons for good or poor performance
- The strength of alignment of NDPs to the SDGs and annual budgets is an important predictor of SDG performance
- ECA developed a digital planning Tool called the Integrated Planning and Reporting Tool to support transparent reporting and alignment of NDPs to the SDGs and the budget.
- It is therefore a vital input into tor VNR and VLR process.

IPRT supports integrated VNR/VLR tracking and

> Horizontal alignment:

- Maps Agenda 2030 with Agenda 2063 to identify synergies and areas of divergence;
- Mapping is done at **goal, target and indicator levels**;
- Vertical alignment of Agendas 2030 and 2063 to NDP and national financing frameworks:
 - Assessment of the degree of alignment at goal, target and indicator level
 - Maps financing frameworks to development priorities;
 - Diagnostic of the results framework
- > Performance tracking of development results and financial indicators:
 - Tracks performance of NDPs and assesses gaps between actual performance and targets;
 - Tracks budget commitments against national development targets;

> Automated reporting on development results and financial indicators:

- Generates reports on the alignment of both agendas into NDPs;
- Generates reports on NDP indicator performance against targets.

SDG tracking is linked to tracking of other Agendas


SDGs vs. DPoA

Horizontal alignment heatmap: SDGs vs A2063


Alignment Heatmap SDGs vs Agenda 2063 On goal level.





Countries are more aligned with Agenda 2063 than Agenda 2030





- The IPRT provides information on the extent to which:
 - countries prioritize the SDGs in their national and subnational plan
 - prioritized SDGs are funded through financing frameworks including the annual budget
- The IPRT also tracks and reports on the performance of SDGaligned indicators in the national plan.
- The reports generated facilitated integrated VNR/VLR reporting






