




Contributing to Covid-19 recovery

- Part of policy response for build-back-better
- Global supply chains disrupted – reset possibilities?
- Pandemic highlighted fragility of globalized supply chains – CE provide more resource independence
- Source of new green jobs and entrepreneurship

Better worker protection

- Occupational health & safety (OHS) training for hybrid & electric vehicle (HEV) owners, garages, dismantlers & scrap metals, first responders, automotive trainers, OHS inspectors
- OHS inspector awareness raising whilst on OHS inspection duties

Improve skills

- Hybrid & electric vehicle (HEV) trainers & tertiary students
- OHS inspectors, vehicle/ scrap metal dismantlers, first responders, HEV owners and HEV garage owners
