UNITED NATIONS HIGH LEVEL DIALOGUE ON ENERGY STAKEHOLDERS THEMATIC E-CONSULTATION

Provide inputs to the stakeholders thematic e-consultation for the United Nations High Level Dialogue on Energy!

BACKGROUND

The General Assembly, through its resolution 74/225, invited the Secretary-General, with the support of the relevant United Nations system entities, to convene [a high-level dialogue in 2021](#) to promote the implementation of the energy-related goals and targets of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development in support of the implementation of the United Nations Decade of Sustainable Energy for All (2014–2024) and the Paris Agreement.

The [High-level Dialogue on Energy](#), to be held in September 2021, represents the first global gathering on energy under the auspices of the United Nations General Assembly since 1981. It provides a historic opportunity to drive energy transformation in the first years of the SDG Decade of Action and support the implementation of the Paris Agreement.

The Dialogue calls for concrete actions to further accelerate the implementation of Sustainable Development Goal 7 in support of the 2030 Agenda and the Paris Agreement. Moreover, it is expected that the Dialogue will also feature additional voluntary commitments, including ‘Energy Compacts’, by Member States and non-state actors such as companies and sub-national authorities.

STAKEHOLDERS THEMATIC E-CONSULTATION

The High-level Dialogue on Energy will be structured around five overarching themes, in order to ensure an inclusive process for engagement of Member States and other stakeholders to identify, develop and accelerate action for universal energy access, energy transitions and energy’s interlinkages with other SDGs.

Those themes are: (1) Energy access; (2) Energy transition. (3) Enabling SDGs through inclusive, just energy transitions; (4) Innovation, technology and data and (5) Finance and investment. More information about the overarching themes can be found [here](#).
