Mr. Amson Sibanda, Chief, National Strategies and Capacity Building Branch, Division for Sustainable Development Goals, United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN DESA).



Dr. Amson Sibanda leads and manages the activities undertaken by the Branch that support DESA's operational work aimed at developing capacities of developing countries to translate internationally agreed policy frameworks and programmes at global, regional and country-levels. He has worked in SADC countries, namely Zimbabwe, Zambia, Mozambique, Malawi and Namibia. In February 2021, Basera was named the Young Corporate Director for the year 2020 by the Institute of Corporate Directors Zimbabwe (ICDZ).

In 2004, he transferred to the World Bank in Washington DC, United States, as Legal Officer/Counsel in the Environment and International Law Unit, Legal Department. He returned to FAO headquarters in 2010, where he served as Legal Officer in the Development Law Service, Legal Office. He holds a Doctor of Philosophy in International Environmental Law and Public Law from the University of Limoges in France.
