Thanks to the joint efforts by you and by all participants, the 2<sup>nd</sup> UN Global Sustainable Transport Conference completed all agenda items and is about to close with full success. On behalf of the host country of the Conference, I'd like to extend my sincere gratitude to all participants, online and in person.

This 3-day Conference features keynote speech by Chinese President Xi Jinping, statement by UN Secretary General Guterres, as well as the presence and statement by 5 heads of state and government at the opening ceremony. Delegates from 171 countries take part in the Conference online or in person. Ladies and gentlemen, dear friends,

We have a long way to go to achieve sustainable development. In his keynote speech, President Xi Jinping expressed his wish that all parties actively join the Global Development Initiative proposed by China, so as to join hands to speed up implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and promote more robust, greener and more balanced global development. China is ready to work with all parties to comprehensively advance implementation of the Global Development Initiative as soon as possible, while at the same time continue to advance high-quality Belt and Road cooperation so as to speed up implementation of the 2030 Agenda and bring tangible benefits to peoples of all countries.
