

OPEN CALL for Proposals: 2022 SDGs Learning, Training & Practice

The United Nations Department of Economic and Social Affairs (UN DESA) and the United Nations Institute for Training and Research (UNITAR) are organizing the 2022 edition of the **SDGs Learning, Training & Practice** – a series of capacity building and knowledge learning sessions held as a Special Event of the 2022 High-level Political Forum on Sustainable Development (HLPF).

The **2022 SDG Learning, Training and Practice Special Event** will align with the 2022 HLPF theme: *"Building back better from the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) while advancing the full implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development"*.

It will feature speakers and experts from many sectors on crucial topics related to the implementation of the SDGs to be reviewed at the 2022 HLPF: SDG 4, SDG 5, SDG 14, SDG 15 and SDG 17.

Guidelines:

- Only submissions in English will be considered
- Only ONE proposal per entity
- Applicants could indicate preference for virtual or in-person sessions
- NO fee for submission or approval of proposed courses
- Submissions will be evaluated based on quality of proposals, relevance to the HLPF theme and the SDGs under review, expertise of the organizers and willingness to produce the desired output
- Selected organizers will be notified no later than 30 May 2022.
