Building blocks & guidance

- DESA prepared Global Guiding Elements, which draw from the Secretary-General's common voluntary guidelines for the VNRs
- Provide a proposed shared structure for the reports, and at minimum, give a checklist of issues that could be reflected in the process



- ❖ Fully compatible with other, more detailed guidance documents, including the Africa Regional Guidelines, developed by UNECA
- ❖ Aim at fostering a dialogue between the Voluntary National Reviews and the VLRs, where applicable

VLR coordination, stakeholder engagement, selection of priority SDGs

Policy and enabling environment

- Describe the relationship between the subnational and national levels
- SDG awareness
- Incorporation of the SDGs in local plans
- leaving no one behind
- Institutional mechanisms/governance

Progress on goals and targets

- Analysis of the progress of all/selected SDGs
- Are reference data available? How is progress monitored?
- Means of implementation (financial, capacity building)
