



Regional distribution of registrants









- → First draft discussion paper prepared

Expected outputs:

- Policy discussion paper and recommendations for action
- Online catalogue of good practices
- A set of ideas for action or concrete commitments at the September
 Summit

Next steps:

Under the leadership of nominated Member States

- > Further develop the paper
- Actively identify and compile more good practices
- Refine and strengthen recommendations drawing on evidence
