


Background




Overview of Inputs to the Mapping






Initiatives by Category





Number of Programmes/Projects Launched






Initiatives by Continent





Initiatives by SDGs






Inter-Agency Partnerships

- 203 initiatives were implemented by a single UN entity;
- 286 initiatives involved partners, with 75 of these initiatives having one partner;
- Partnerships are diverse, ranging from governments, UN entities, private sectors, academia and civil societies.






Cross-continental Partnerships
