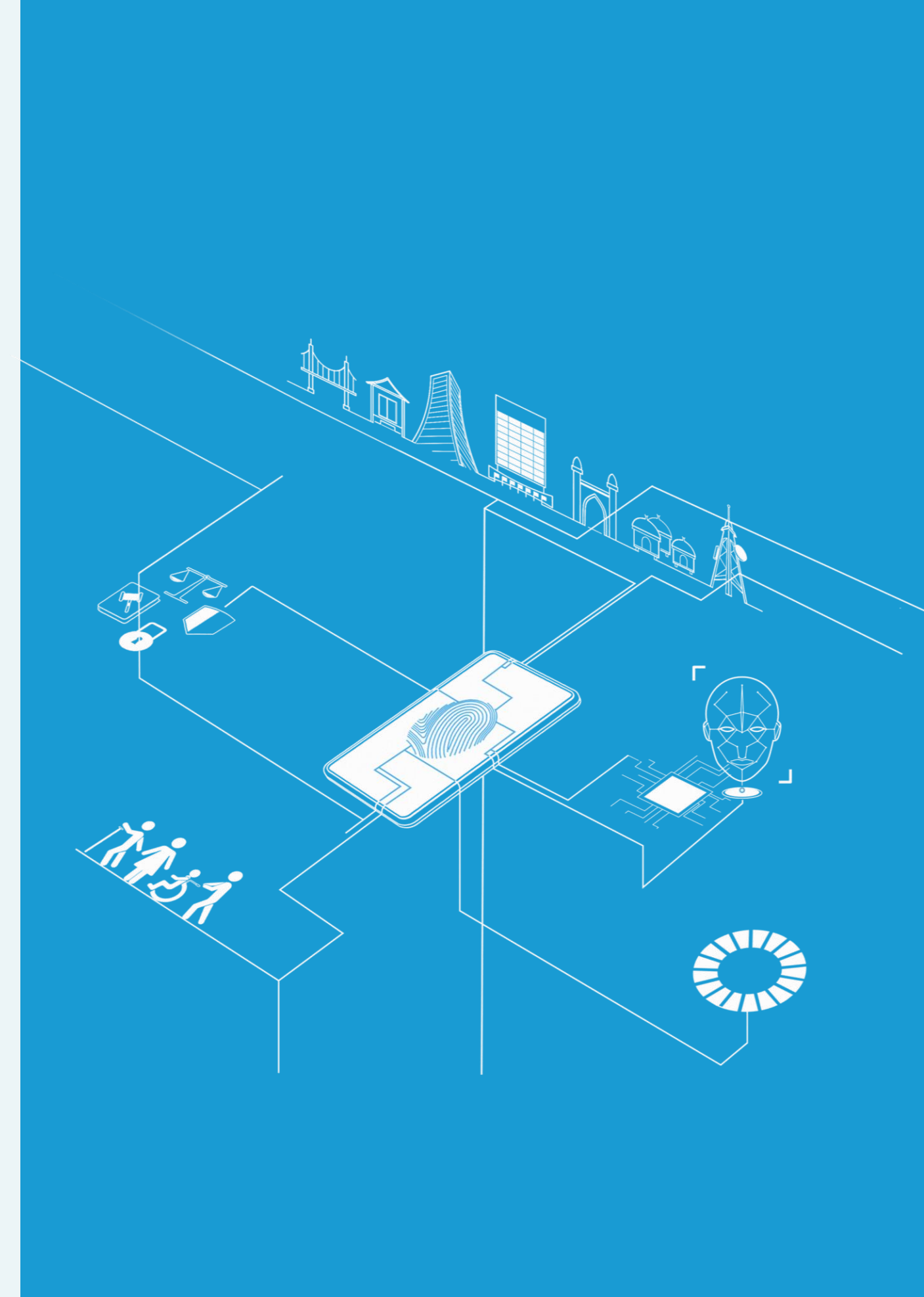
Background

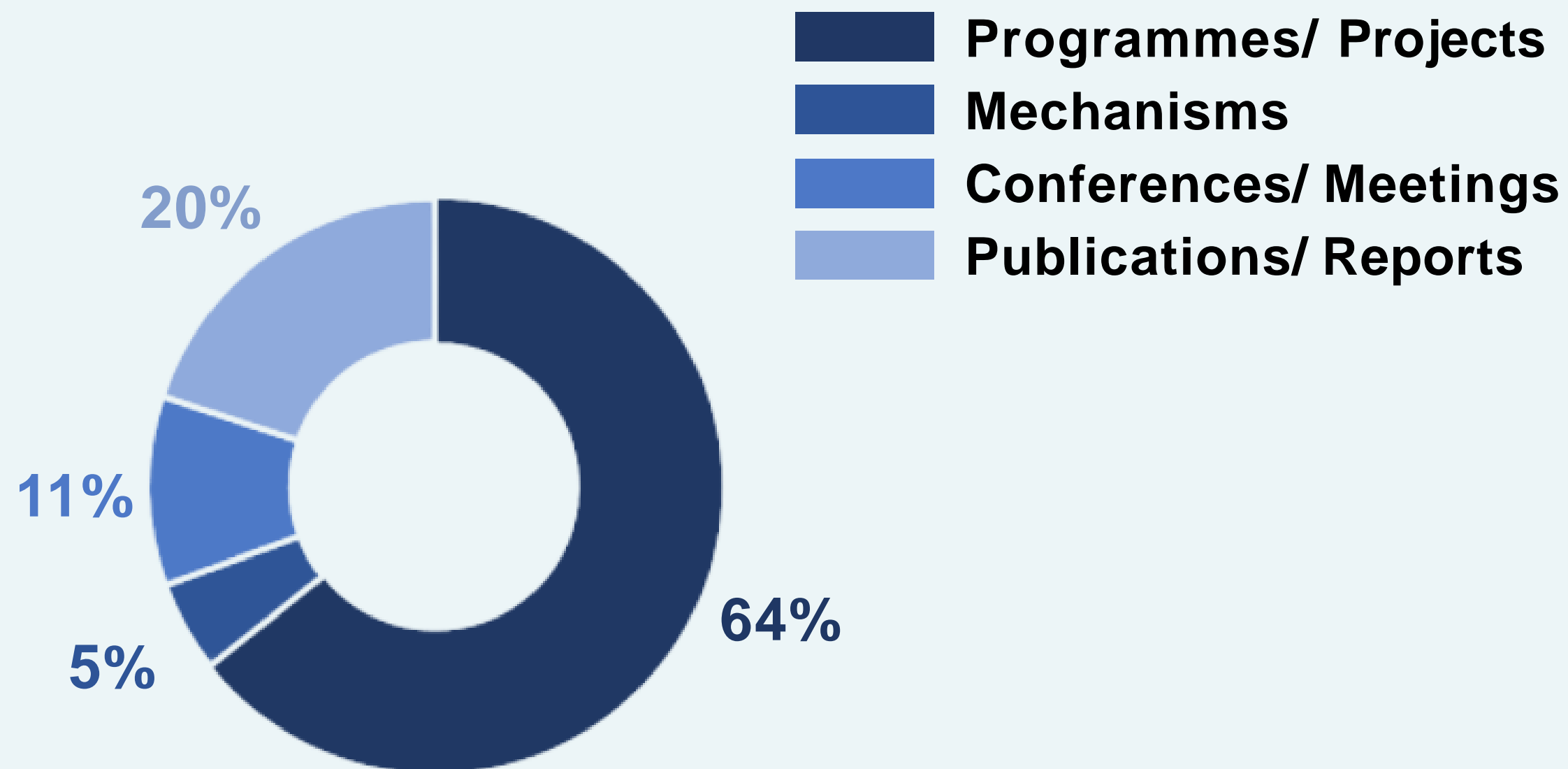

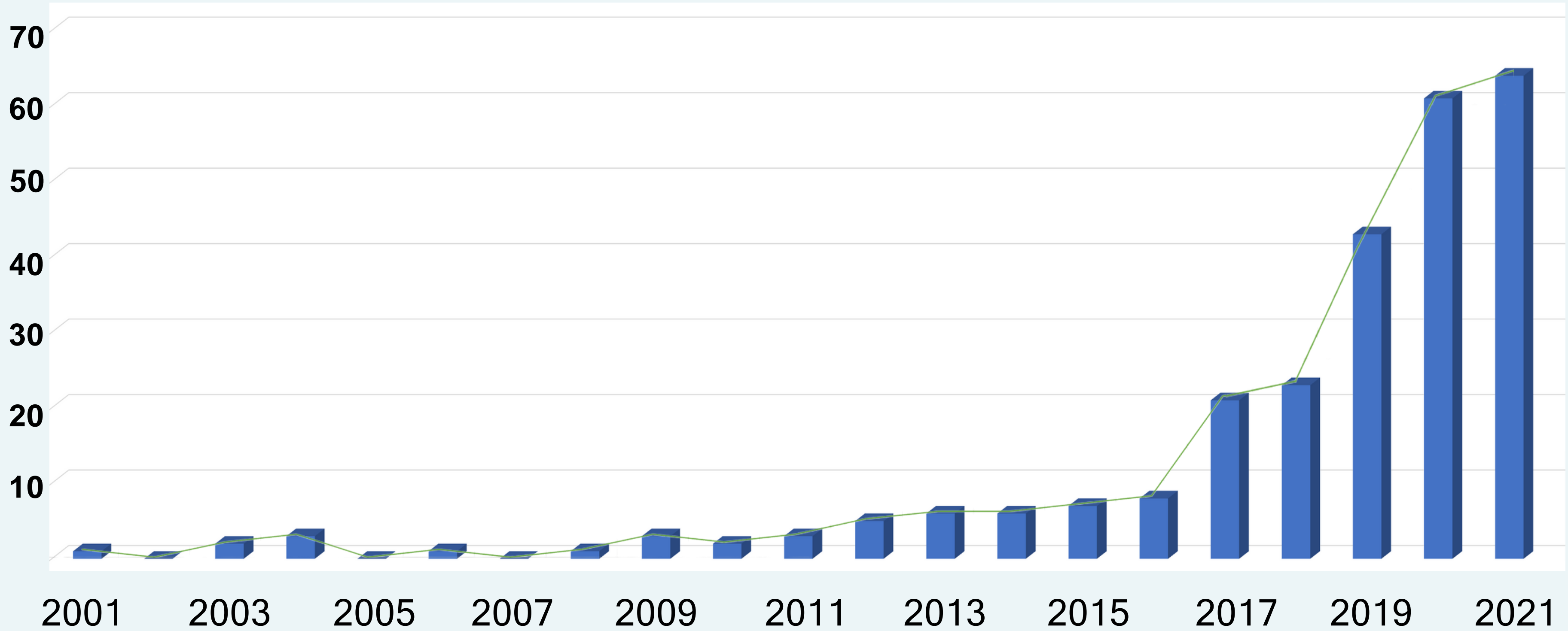

Initiatives by Category



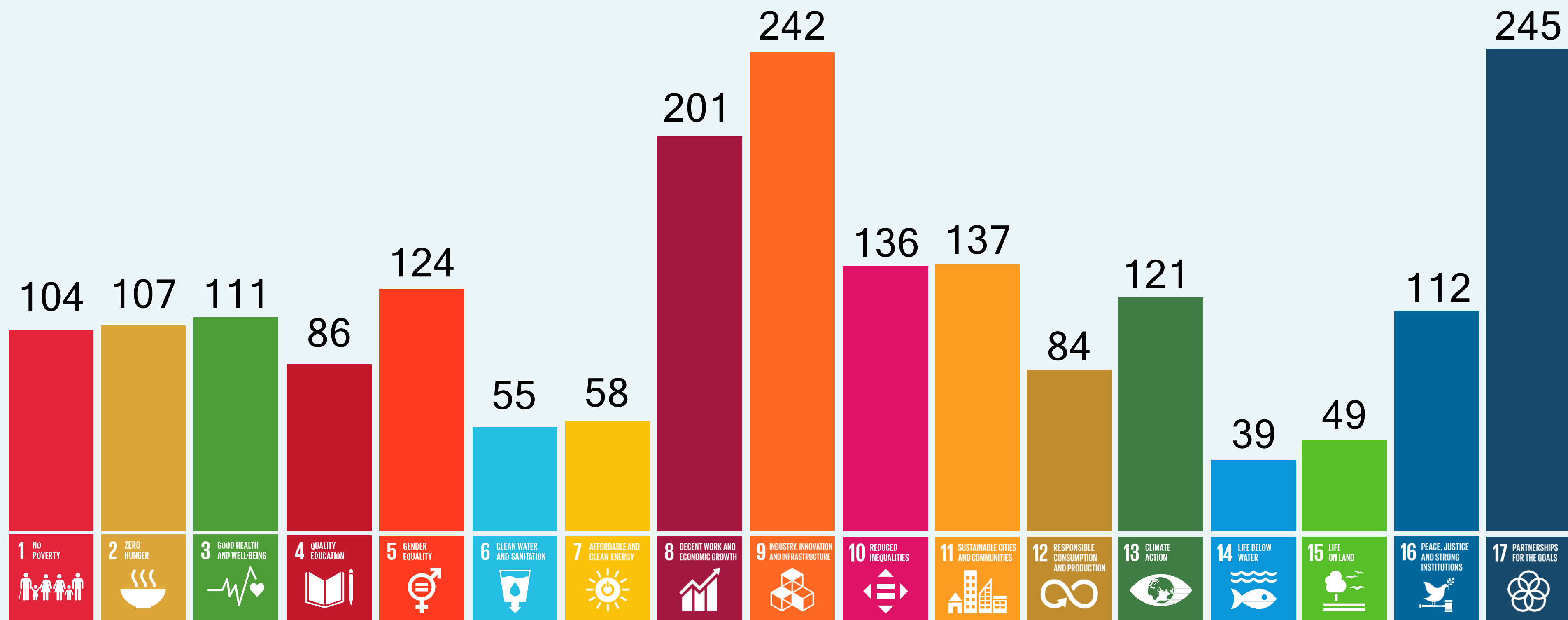
Number of Programmes/Projects Launched

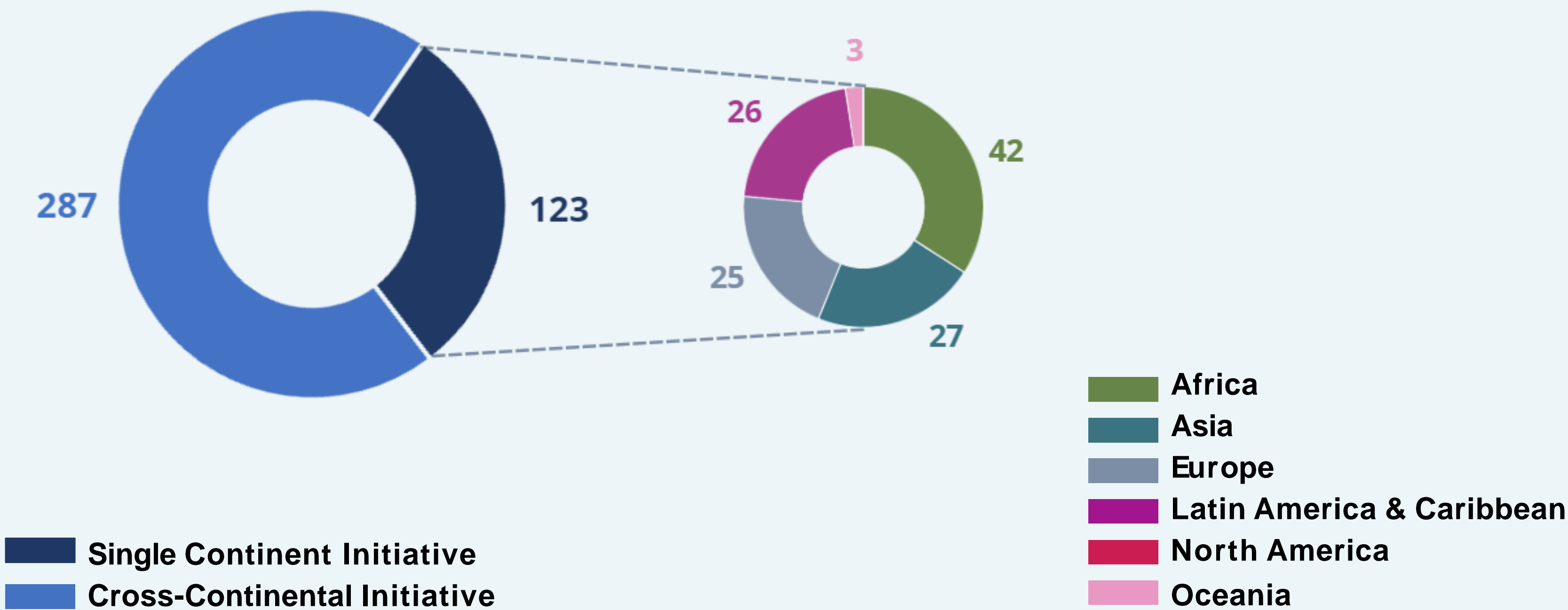


Inter-Agency Partnerships

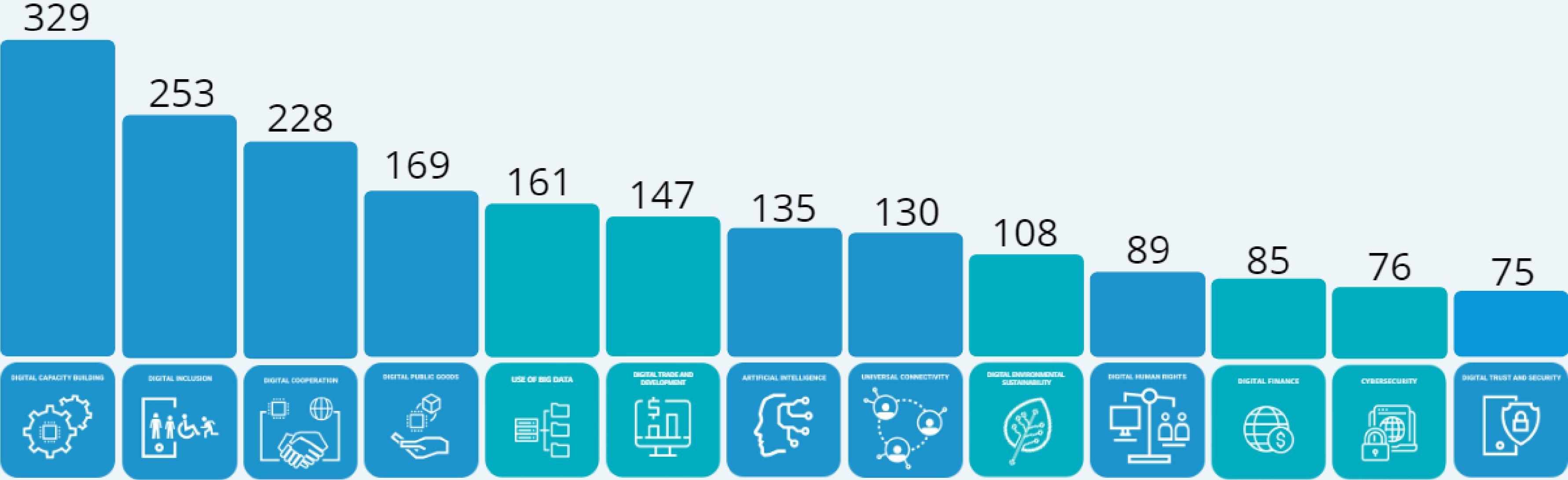
- 203 initiatives were implemented by a single UN entity;
