BACKGROUND

In response to the Secretary-General's call for a Decade of Action to deliver the SDGs by 2030, the UN-Water family launched the <u>SDG 6 Global Acceleration</u> Framework in 2020. The SDG 6 Global Acceleration Framework aims to deliver fast results for SDG 6 while strengthening system-wide collaboration at the country level. The five accelerators outlined in the Framework – Financing, Data and Information, Capacity Development, Innovation, and Governance – will focus the international community's support to country progress.

In less than a year, the international community will gather in New York for the most important water conference in a generation: the <u>UN 2023 Water</u> <u>Conference</u>. The co-hosts of the Conference, the Republic of Tajikistan and the Kingdom of the Netherlands, are striving to make the Conference a watershed moment for the world. As we approach next year's historic Conference, acceleration and preparatory events in the context of the Conference will be presented. The event will also feature the Water and Climate Coalition that leads the change for a more resilient world by bringing the Integrated Water and Climate Agenda to the global political arena.
