WOA needs a boost in communication for the importance it has – being the key group and report around Ocean Science in multidisciplinary way should be better known by all stakeholders – it is critical also that everyone knowns how important the UN is as a hub for this kind of studies

Women have bonds with the Ocean with a strong perception on its health as a precondition for Humanity's good future. To protect it is to protect us all. Support women and sea programs is a positive step. Devotion, passion, justice, dignity, call for action and women empowerment are key for a successful present and a better future.

Protected areas include from mountain to Ocean care and better acknowledgement on how much we all need a well-preserved Nature. Conservation film is more important than ever and shall be more supported. It has a key role in bringing more and more stories around it, from the biodiversity we can find close to us no matter where we are to the wild places that we need so much to respect.

Sea and Space are closely interconnected with the same zero gravity spaces, essays made in one to use at the other and both are so critical to understand better the vast unknown Ocean while testing space habitats. Scientific achievements at these spots

are game changers. To build the next International Ocean Station is on its way by Fabien Cousteau, a mobile International Station by Jacques Rougerie and the next Moon habitat by Peter Weiss.

Overfishing and Ocean Health are connected, and we need to take more serious actions around practices like shark finning, overfishing and bycatch.
