Symposium - Talking about Ocean Conservation in Portuguese

Background on the event (one paragraph)

AIMM – Marine Environment Research Association in partnership with Instituto Meros do Brasil and Biosfera Cabo Verde, promoted the Symposium "Talking about Ocean Conservation in Portuguese" as a side event of the 2022 UN Ocean Conference. The Symposium took place on the 27 June 2022, at 1pm – 5pm (GMT+1). The goal of this Symposium was to promote knowledge exchange and to raise awareness about the ongoing initiatives regarding ocean conservation throughout countries that share a common language, members of CPLP.

Key Issues discussed (5-8 bullet points)

- Conservation photography without borders
- The use of natural resources in marine protected areas
- Sea turtles in Angola and São Tomé and Príncipe
- Impact of climate change on the marine environment
- Conservation of cetaceans in southern Portugal
- Biodiversity and Conservation
- Sustainable fishing

Key recommendations for action (5 - 6 bullet points)

- Act more locally with smaller projects and involving the communities- more tangible and doable goals
- The need to implement programs to monitor biodiversity protect to conserve
- The need to pursue the implementation of new MPAs
- Projects that promote ocean literacy
- Capacity building in the area of marine conservation
- Foster national and international collaborations with different NGOs, universities and stakeholders.
