Singapore's input/comment on the draft MVI interim report

Singapore's comments:

We would like to suggest that geographical size be considered as a possible indicator under the dimensions of economic vulnerability and environmental vulnerability of the MVI framework. For small states such as Singapore, our small size (and other geographical/geophysical factors including relatively flat land) limits the options for mitigating and adapting against the impact of climate change. For instance, while larger countries have the option of shifting their capital to another city, some smaller countries do not have such an option available to them.
