- An SDG network for six largest cities in Finland
 - Helsinki, Espoo, Oulu, Tampere, Turku, Vantaa
 - Facilitated by the Association of Finnish Local and Regional Authorities
 - In close cooperation with the Finnish SDG ecosystem
 - Prime Minister's Office, especially Finnish National Commission on Sustainable Development, Ministry of the Environment, the scientific community, think tanks, projects on sustainable development etc
- Promotes the national and international influence of the six cities in the context of SDG work and cooperation with the regional actors
 - Joint statement with URBACT Global Goals for Cities and Nordregio
 - "Call to the Eurocities on Strengthening Cooperation and Cocreation with European cities in the Context of Sustainable Development Goals and Voluntary Local Reviews"
 - released in Eurocities AGM Espoo, June 8th 2022
