




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STATISTICAL PERFORMANCE INDEX 0 (WORST) TO 100 (BEST)





- Most of the population lives in that region on rural areas;
- Coastal provinces sufer with extreme climate events;
- Inland regions are affected by erosion;


### 5 categories of vulnerability

- Discrimination
- Geography

### Live no one behind on provincial level

- Identify gaps on the provincial strategy in terms of coverage of groups needs;
- Evaluate if the province need to prioritize the coverage of some groups needs;
- Identify how to solve the gaps on actual plans
