- Duration autumn 2022-winter 2023

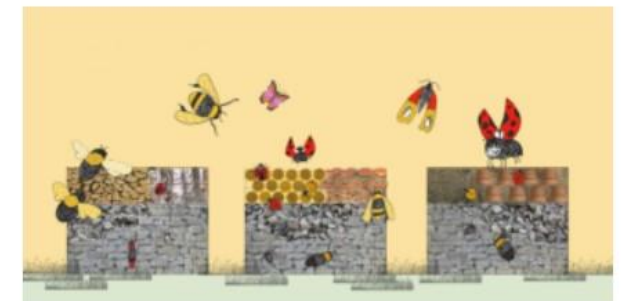
