## Background

The High-Level Political Forum (HLPF) is the main platform to review the progress on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). Each year, a subset of the goals is reviewed in depth and in 2023, SDGs 6, 7, 9, 11, and 17 are under review. SDG 6 (clean water and sanitation) is especially important this year as the HLPF follows the UN 2023 Water Conference in March and precedes the SDG Summit in September where additional support will be galvanized to achieve the lofty aims of the SDGs.

Water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH) are at the heart of child well-being and are foundational for children and their communities to experience life in all its fullness. However, millions of people still lack access to basic water and sanitation services. Growing global and regional problems, including climate change, political instability, economic crises, long-term effects of COVID-19, and other yet unknown issues are challenging hard fought gains in WASH services. Sustained commitment and investment in the sector are needed to ensure that everyone has access to clean and safe WASH services.

WASH is central to the achievement of all the SDGs. Access to safely managed WASH services is essential for improved child well-being, health, nutrition, education, and overall outcomes. Simply stated, WASH services that are safe, plentiful, inclusive, and sustained are transformative. Transformative WASH relieves families of concerns about the quality, accessibility, or reliability of services, and leads to flourishing communities.

In this learning session, we will explore the connection of WASH to other SDGs to illuminate interlinkages and allow for alignment between diverse stakeholders.
