• Founded in 1994 by 8 nations: Australia, France, Japan, Jamaica, the Philippines, Sweden, United Kingdom, and the United States of America.


• The Initiative has grown to 101 members, 45 countries accounting for over 75% of the world's coral reefs.

• The Plan of Action is composed of 4 central themes:




