We have the honour to address you in our capacity as Co-Chairs of the Preparatory Committee of the Fourth International Conference on Small Island Developing States.

Reference is made to the letter of the Co-Chairs dated 19 December 2023 regarding the invitation to the first session of the Preparatory Committee for the Fourth International Conference on Small Island Developing States (SIDS4) scheduled for 22-26 January 2024 at the United Nations Headquarters in New York.

Annexed also to this letter is the draft decision submitted by the Co-Chairs for adoption by the Preparatory Committee regarding the accreditation of non-governmental organizations, major groups and other relevant stakeholders, issued as document A/CONF.223/2024/PC/L.3.
