IOM congratulates the Preparatory Committee for the substantive preparations for the 4th SIDS Conference. The Conference is a significant opportunity to mobilize all stakeholders to work towards sustainable development for SIDS – and to design a new, focused, and forward-looking programme of action - and a monitoring framework - for the next ten years.

With diverse characteristics and contexts, SIDS present the complex and dynamic interlinkages between human mobility and development.
