- **1. National Strategy for Sustainable Development** (2030 Agenda in Italy) as reference framework and roadmap to the future
- **2. «Localizing the SDGs»** Territories at the **core** of the practical and effective implementation
- 3. Participation of, and among, institutions, territorial bodies and non-state actors, as *ordinary* working method to ensure horizontal and vertical cooperation multilevel and multi-stakeholder governance
- **4. Policy coherence for sustainable development** for the full implementation of 2030 Agenda principles and objectives and for **multi-level and sectoral integration**


