Summary

Insightful Actions and Innovative Solutions

- The session highlighted the importance of **multi-stakeholder partnerships (MSPs)** in tackling complex issues such as rising obesity and diabetes rates among children.
- **Innovative exercises** were conducted to illustrate the power of collaboration. An icebreaker quiz showcased famous partnerships, emphasizing the strength found in unity and cooperation.
- Participants were divided into breakout rooms to design partnerships aimed at improving children's nutrition. This exercise showcased how different stakeholders, such as government ministries, local media, farmers, and UN agencies, can bring unique resources and perspectives to address a common goal.
- Key initiatives discussed included leveraging local media for advocacy, incorporating
 nutritional education in school curricula, and engaging farmers to shift to more nutritious
 crops.

Enhanced Knowledge and Skills

Key Learnings:

- **Stakeholder Mapping**: Participants learned the importance of identifying and involving relevant stakeholders who can contribute effectively to partnership goals.
- **Communication Skills**: Emphasis was placed on establishing a common language and respectful dialogue among partners from different sectors.
- **Context Analysis**: Understanding the social and political context was highlighted as crucial for aligning strategies and preventing duplication of efforts.
- **Leadership and Responsibility**: Participants developed skills in creating core groups and ensuring high-level support to drive partnership initiatives forward.

Practical Skills:

- Designing effective partnerships by combining resources from various stakeholders.
- Conducting context and stakeholder analyses to identify key players and resources.
- Creating frameworks for action, defining objectives, and ensuring shared responsibility among partners.
- Addressing power imbalances and fostering trust within partnerships.

Expanded Network and Collaboration

- The session facilitated networking through **interactive exercises** and **breakout room discussions**.
- Participants from diverse backgrounds, including government, private sector, academia, and civil society, had the opportunity to connect and discuss potential collaborations.
- **Case studies and examples** provided during the session illustrated successful partnerships, inspiring participants to consider similar approaches in their contexts.

Plans for Maintaining Connections:

- Participants were encouraged to use the resources and tools provided to initiate and sustain partnerships.
- Follow-up sessions and continued engagement through the Partnership Accelerator and TPI were recommended to maintain momentum and support ongoing collaboration.
