- The 17 SDGs, 169 targets and 232 indicators to be achieved by all member states by 2030
- SDGS aim to transform our world.
- Expectations are that we see changes in ending poverty & inequality, protect the planet, and ensuring that all people enjoy health, justice and prosperity.
- **How do we see the changes?**
- **Monitoring and evaluation tool**
 - *An instrument needed to assess the progress and impact of the SDG initiative*
 - *A tool that will be used to collect , track and analyze data*
- **What is used for Reporting?**
 - **SDGs Matrix and Questionnaire**
 - *The tool provides a systematic way to gather information on implementation of the SDGs*
 - *To inform decisions, resource mobilization etc*
