LEVEL OF DISAGGREGATION

- CSO carry out household surveys and censuses
- National level
- Rural / Urban Disaggregation
- Regional level
- Tinkhundla level (Census)

CSO Data for VLR

- Consider urban disaggregation as proxy to data required for VLR as these residents depicts the characteristics of urban setting even if just outside the gazetted town/city boundaries
- Use small area estimation to arrive at town/city level
- CSO partner with towns and cities and provide technical support to conduct specific local area surveys which could be either be qualitative or quantitative (partners identified could be source of funding as data collection is an expensive exercise)

CSO Data for VLR cont.

- Use other data generating models, data forecasting and geospatial technologies.
- Prepared to partner with local governments at all times and provide data as per availability and need
- Municipalities are also encouraged to use data from their own sources which could be own reports and administration data
