What is the UN Decade of Sustainable Transport?

- Declared by the UN General Assembly in 2023 (A/78/148) to take place **2026 – 2035**

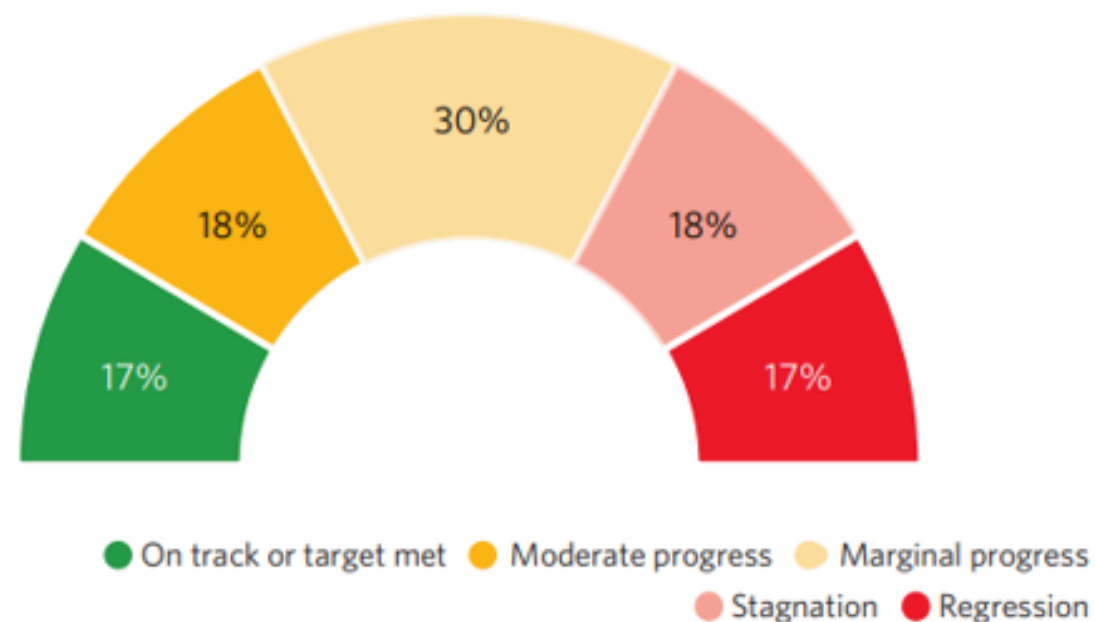
The resolution also:

- Invites the SG to consider convening a **Third UN Conference** on Sustainable Transport
- Calls for **further coordination** among the UN system and other international organizations, relevant international financing institutions, multilateral and bilateral donors and the private sector.
- Builds on resolution “**World Sustainable Transport Day**” (A/RES/77/286)

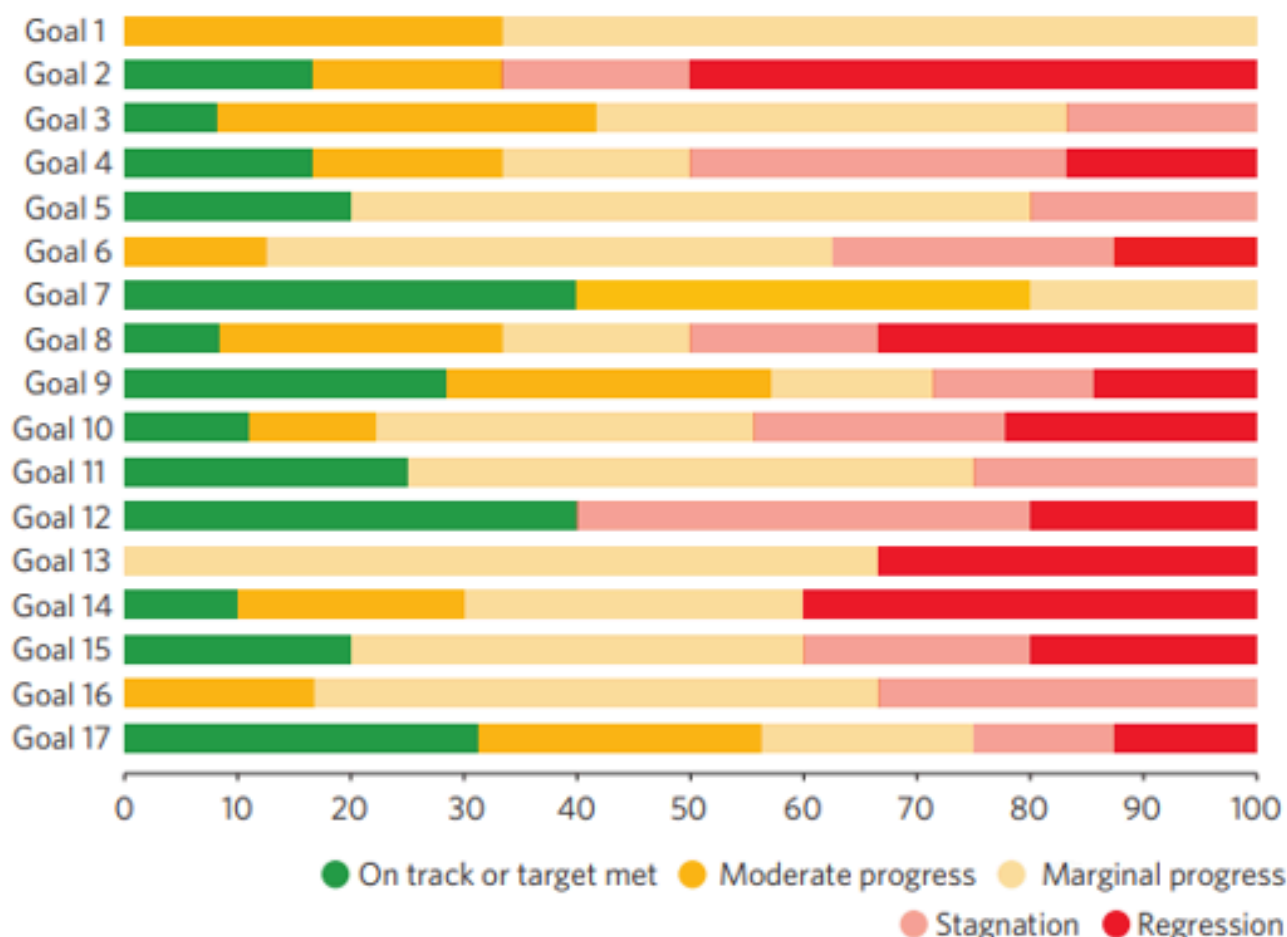
SDG progress is off track with 6 years to 2030

- With six years to 2030, only about **17% of SDG targets with data are on track**.
- Close to half are moderately or severely off track.
- Over a third have stalled or regressed below the 2015 baseline.
- By 2030, **590 million people may still live in extreme poverty** if current trends persist.
- **122 million more suffered from hunger** in 2022 compared to 2019.
- Approximately **1.1 billion people live in slums** or slum-like conditions, with 2 billion more expected in the next 30 years.
- The Paris Agreement is off track, **2023 was warmest year on record** with carbon dioxide levels continuing to rise.

Progress assessment for the 17 Goals based on assessed targets, by Goal (percentage)

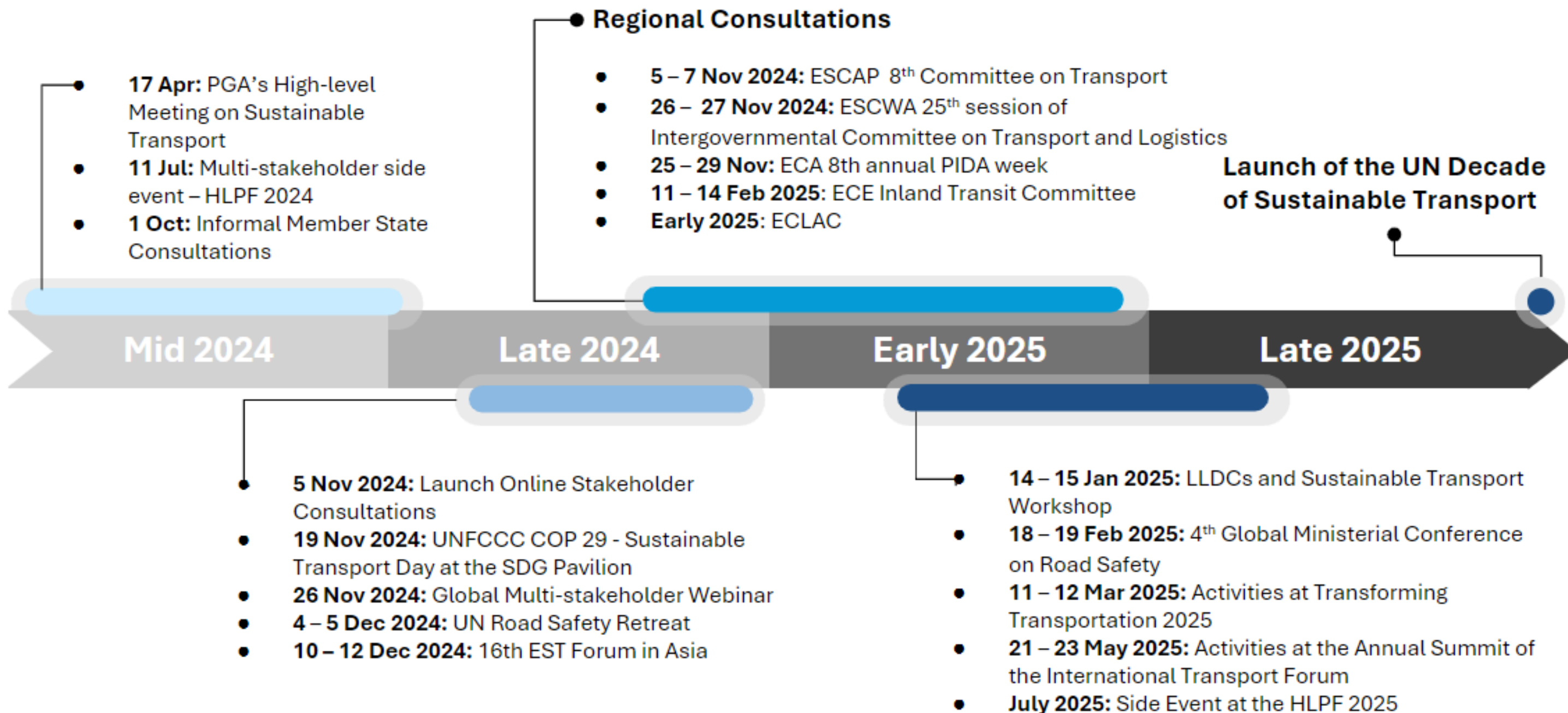


What is the Implementation Plan?

- GA requested DESA to **prepare the Implementation Plan for the UN Decade**
- In collaboration with the **Regional Commissions**
- In consultation with the **Member States**, UN system, intergovernmental organizations and all other relevant stakeholders
- A **global policy document**, not a negotiated outcome
- Prepared with existing resources

Foster new and more impactful **projects, initiatives, and partnerships**



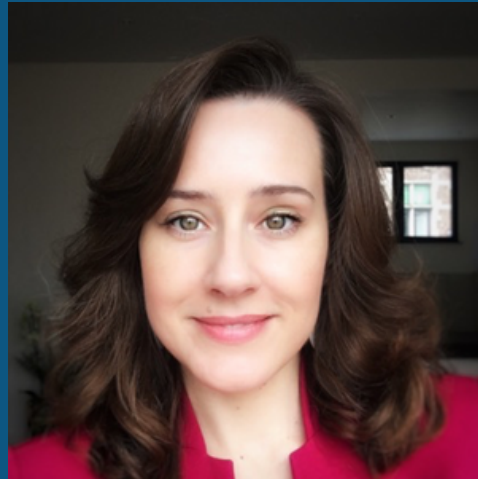
Enhance coordination within the UN and across the transport sector
