Ph MSMEs at a glance...

1,109,684 operating businesses in the country Of these, 1,105,143 (99.59%) are MSMEs

Micro enterprises constitute 90.49% (1,004,195) of total establishments, followed by small enterprises at 8.69% (96,464) and medium enterprises at 0.40% (4,484)

MSMEs constitute over 99% of businesses and generates 65% of employment

Ph Baseline Survey on Digitalization of MSMEs

23% of SMEs do not use digital tools (Level 0); while 51% utilize business email (Level 1); 21% make use of business email and website (Level 2); and 6% employ business email, website, and advanced tools in their business (Level 3)






