Tenth Multi-stakeholder Forum on STI for the SDGs

- 7-8 May 2025 in CR4 with broader STI Week/Days including 6 May
- Convened by the President of ECOSOC H.E. Mr. Bob Rae (Canada) who appointed two co-chairs:

H.E. Mr. Omar Hilale, Ambassador of the Kingdom of Morocco to the UN H.E. Ms. Elina Kalkku, Ambassador of Finland to the UN

- Theme: "Advancing sustainable, inclusive, and evidence-based, science and technology solutions and innovations for the 2030 Agenda and its SDGs for leaving no one behind"
- SDGs under review at 2025 HLPF include:
 - SDG 3 Good health and well-being
 - SDG 5 Gender equality
 - SDG 8 Decent work and economic growth
 - SDG 14 Life below water
 - **SDG 17** Partnerships for the Goals







Context of the 2025 STI Forum

- 10th Anniversary of the STI Forum 10 years of lessons from leveraging STI for the SDGs
- Revitalization of STI Commitments in the Pact of the Future and GDC
- Fourth International Conference on Finance for Development to be held in June 2025
- UN Ocean Conference in June 2025
- High-level political forum in July 2025
- Second World Summit for Social Development in November 2025



Tentative STI Forum Sessions

- 1. Making Artificial Intelligence (AI) accessible, inclusive and beneficial for the SDGs
- 2. Advancing science, technology and innovation for gender equality
- 3. Leveraging science to conserve, restore and sustainably use the ocean and coastal ecosystems
- 4. Scaling up STI financing and capacity building, and strengthening research infrastructures for sustainable development
