Excellencies,

Portugal aligns itself with the statement delivered by the European Union.

Allow me also to congratulate the United Arab Emirates and Senegal for co-hosting the 2026 UN Water Conference.

Portugal is strongly committed and a frontrunner on water management issues. In particular, particularly, we attach great importance to a holistic management of freshwater, coasts, and the ocean. The adoption of a “source to sea” approach, linking SDG6 and SDG14, is critical to ensure a circular vision on human water use and to address the multiple challenges related to freshwater and the ocean that impact sustainable development.

This is why, at the Margins of the 2nd UN Ocean Conference held in Lisbon, Portugal organized a High-Level Symposium on Water that taught us the importance of ensuring that the water and ocean communities learn more about each other, understand the challenges that they face, and build mechanisms aimed at facilitating closer cooperation.
