- 1. First of all...allow me to congratulate...
 - → Minister Dieye of Senegal and Assistant Minister Balalaa of the UAE for their the leadership in preparing for the UN Water Conference 2026...
- 2. I would like to also greet **USG Li Junhua** of DESA for the convening of this Session...

Distinguished delegates, Colleagues,

- 3. This is the moment for water...
- 4. Since the first UN Water Conference in 1977 water has lost it space in the discussions and deliberations within the UN...
- 5. 2023 was a **groundbreaking year**... where the second UN Water Conference took place after almost 50 years had passed...
- 6. Today, once again, we are situated in another important point... where the preparation for the **third UN Water Conference** is started...
- 7. Hence, this is a moment not to be wasted...
 - → A moment for us to "shape" our water...

Colleagues,

- 8. Water is life... and there is no life without water...
 - → We all are agreeing to this fundamental truth...
- 9. **Unfortunately,** our water continues to face **challenges**... that are getting **more complex** than ever...
- 10. Exacerbated by climate change... 2024 has been claimed to be **the warmest year in record**...
 - → With that, 2024 has become a year of extreme droughts in many parts of the world... disrupting our foods... livelihoods... environments... and worsening poverty...
- 11. In the same year **water-related disasters**, such as floods, have affected at least 40 millions people... causing economic loss as much as 550 billion US Dollars...
- 12. If this trend continues... by 2050 more than three-quarters of the world's population will be severely affected by droughts and other water-disasters...

- 13. In this situation, our **only option** is to work **five-times and six-times harder**... to **put concrete actions for our water**...
- 14. The **UN Water Conference 2026** is one of the means to do that...

Excellencies, Distinguished delegates,

- 15. While we are focusing on discussions about the priority themes of the UN Water Conference... allow me to encourage you to keep several keyprinciples in mind...
- 16. First, our vision of the Conference must be grounded and be built upon the pressing needs in real life...
 - → The Conference must, at all cost, avoid practice as usual of sessions without actions...
 - → It must aim to ensure that the benefits of the Conference concretely help the people who are most in-need...
 - → The Conference must aim to resolve the challenges faced by women, children, persons with disabilities, people living in rural areas, and others who have limited access to clean and safe water... and are affected by water-related challenges...
 - → It must also aim to build a water resilience future where water- disasters are no longer a risk to development and livelihood.
 - → And it must ensure that water, especially through SDG 6, contributes to all development goals environment, social, and economic development.
- 17. **Second,** the UN Water Conference must include **innovations as game** changer in water efforts.
 - → Technology development... and new-models of partnerships between stakeholders... are among the elements of innovations we must not overlook...
- 18. With innovative solutions we can resolve the existing challenges... such as **financing and limited-capacities** in **most developing countries**.
- 19. **Third,** our vision and aspiration must be built **upon concrete commitments to put actions**...
 - → This is the key recipe to have a UN Water Conference that is action oriented...
- 20. **Last**, we must use the Conference to strategize our water actions **many steps** ahead...

→ The UN Water Conference must not fail to **foresee actions that are needed** to ensure **water stays as a priority in our future**... post-2026, post-2028, and post-2030...

Excellencies, Distinguished delegates,

- 21. I look forward to hearing your inputs and work with all of you in making the UN Water Conference a success...
- 22. With my "Triple A" principles Advocacy, Alignment, and Acceleration... I am ready to support the preparation of a Conference... and push for progress in global water agenda...
- 23. Again...This is the moment of water...
 - → The moment to advocate... to align... and to accelerate actions on water.
