5 mins	Opening by HESI Co-Chairs and overview of the Networking Forum
10 mins	Welcome to HESI – Introduction to the world of HESI, including the annual HESI Global Forum

	 Where are you based, and what's your role in your institution or organization? What does sustainable development mean to you personally or professionally? Have you collaborated with other institutions or organizations on sustainable development issues?

15 mins Introduction to HESI's UN Partners

Presentations by UN partners highlighting their higher education-related work in support of sustainable development, including UN DESA, UNESCO, UN University, UNEP, UN Global Compact's Principles for Responsible Management Education (PRME), UN-HABITAT, UNCTAD, UNITAR, the UN Office for Partnerships, and UN Academic Impact.

Participants may choose breakout rooms based on interest.

15 mins Introduction to HESI Action Groups

Brief overview (5 mins) followed by breakout group presentations (10 mins) by the HESI Action Groups, including opportunities to learn how to get involved and a short Q&A.

- 2. Student Action Group
- 3. Rankings, ratings, and assessments
- 4. Education for Green Jobs
- 5. SDG Publishers Compact
