#### Introduction

The opening session of the 2025 SDGs in Practice will be held in person on 14 July from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM (Conference Room 11). This session will focus on advancing capacities and providing learning opportunities to support the HLPF 2025 theme: *"Advancing sustainable, inclusive, science-and evidence-based solutions for the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development and its Sustainable Development Goals for leaving no one behind".* 

As part of the Opening Session, UNITAR will invite Dr. Yasar Jarrar, Co-Founder & Managing Partner, International Advisory Group, who will deliver a keynote address presenting a case study on two recent reports on public administration in the digital age. The presentation will focus on two key reports:

- 1. The "Arab Public Administration Report: Productivity in the Digital Age"
  - a. Captures the perspectives of 1,600+ Arab civil servants on public sector productivity
  - b. Explores how technology and AI are reshaping government operations
  - c. Combines surveys, literature review, and expert insights to analyze public sector trends
- 2. Launch of the "Arab Government Modernization Agenda" Report
  - a. A new report detailing the top 10 trends observed over recent years from a survey of over 10,000 Arab government officials
  - b. Proposal of a roadmap for the future in a whitepaper published by Gov Campus / the International Advisory Group

The Opening Segment will also feature a multisectoral panel consisting of representatives from the UN, Civil Service Organizations, Private Sector, and Academia, to speak about Sustainable, Inclusive, and Evidence-Based Solutions in their respective fields and topics of specialization in regard to advancing the 2030 Agenda and its Sustainable Development Goals. The panelists will be carefully chosen to align with the SDGs in Review at HLPF in 2025.
