








Social Protection M&E

To facilitate the collection, analysis, and use of social protection data to enable *progress* tracking and inform management decision-making.

Main Purpose of M&E system

To facilitate the effective and efficient monitoring and evaluation of the RGC's social protection investment and ensure the achievement of NSPPF goals.



Web-based System

Accessible anywhere, available anytime, centralized security, computer and Internet connection required.


Two main components of M&E system

Adaptive Social Protection: Shock Responsive Social Protection



Leverage the use of the current the social protection system to provide systematic, predictable, timely and effective measure for the citizens, especially the poor and at-risk households in response to

- 1. Natural disasters Shock: Floor and Drought
- 2. Macroeconomic and financial Shock
- 3. Public health crises Shock

Figure 1: Ways in which social protection systems can support shock response

DESIGN TWEAKS: Modifying design & implementation of routine social protection programmes to ensure they are resilient, accessible & effective during shocks


NEW EMERGENCY SP PROGRAMME: Implementing a new, temporary emergency social protection programme using existing social protection systems

VERTICAL EXPANSION: scaling up the social protection benefits package provided to routine social protection programme beneficiaries

HORIZONTAL EXPANSION: broadening coverage of routine social protection programmes to by a shock

EMERGENCY PROGRAMME BY DM ACTORS: Extending access to social protection delivery systems, data or institutions to DM actors, include those affected to support implementation of other temporary emergency programmes














ROUTINE SYSTEM STRENGTHENING:

Ensuring social protection systems are efficient and effective is the foundation of shock responsive social protection

The SRSP Framework will allow the RGC to *use the social protection* to provide systematic, predictable, timely and effective protection in response to shocks through deployment of a set of specific interventional measures using *existing database systems and delivery mechanisms* to protect citizens, especially the poor, the vulnerable groups, and the group vulnerable to shocks.
