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CHANGE IN STATS SA MANDATE



- The Stats Amendment Act no. 29 of 2024 was proclaimed on the 19 September 2025 by the President of South Africa.
- The **proclamation** was **gazetted** on the **30 September 2025** to announce that the Act will come into operation on the **1 October 2025**.
- The amendment designates the SG as the head of Stats SA and the SG of the Republic of South Africa
 - SG responsible for coordination and production of official and other statistics in NSS
 - Enhance and establish partnerships within the NSS to increase the body of official statistics in SA







SG's CO-ORDINATION TOOLS



The SG developed tools to enable him to coordinate the production of statistics in the Republic and address gaps identified in the NSS



Integrated Indicator Framework (IIF) – data gap




South African Statistical Quality Assessment Framework (SASQAF) – quality gap








WHAT IS SASQAF?


- South African Statistical Quality Assessment Framework
 (SASQAF) is a framework that the Statistician-General uses to
 evaluate the quality of statistics produced by organs of state
 and to declare such statistics as official statistics.
- **SASQAF** is available for use by **NSS** entities as a tool to improve the quality of their statistical production system
- **Certifies data** series as **official statistics** if they meet the SASQAF quality criteria (other or national statistics).



SASQAF codifies the language of Quality

SASQAF subscribes to the UN Fundamental Principles of Official Statistics









SDG Reports on Progress Made



Following the baseline report in 2017, South Africa further produced;

- 2019 and 2023 SDG Country Reports with 64.0% and
 72.3% data availability respectively
- The 2025 SDG Country Report is currently underway
- Data used in these reports are a feeder into the
 Voluntary National Review (VNR) processes.







SUITE OF SA'S SDG INDICATORS



251 SDG indicators – 5 N/A to SA

(234 unique; 246 used for reporting in SA)



Domesticated (Proxy) indicators in line with the principle of domestication, ensuring indicators are adjusted to meet local peculiarities. (54)




Additional (Supplementary) indicators will be included where the SDG indicators are not sufficient or are not applicable to explain the situation in the country. (30)










SA DATA AVAILABILITY BY GOAL 2025 (207/246)










SDG DATA FOR REPORTING IN SA

- Quality of data used for official reporting in South Africa should be known – be inline with SASQAF requirements:
 - Online self-assessment https://webuat.statssa.gov.za/SasqafOnline/
 - Independent Quality Assessment
 - SASQAF dipstick form to be completed by all data providers
- Data used for SDG reporting in SA domestic sources;
- Data source/product needs to be sustainable

TIPS FOR COMPILING VLRs





- Ensure the quality of your data is known
- Selection of goals/targets/indicators should be done inline with data you have available
- Use a mixture of quantitative and qualitative data
- Ensure involvement of Stats SA when selecting data to be used for reporting
- Familiarise yourself with **UN SDG metadata** and **Global indicator framework** documents
