Scenario roadmap	 <u>Relative to action 1</u>: As an implementation of the Action 1 (Catalyzing Changes, Building Partnerships and International Cooperation), the Panel issues a statement encouraging the consideration of reforming the institutional architecture of water cooperation, in support to the implementation of the water related SDGs. The Panel also lends its support to establishing the Water Decade for Sustainable Development as well as the establishing of an International Scientific Panel on Water. The statement could be issued upon endorsement by the Panel Members at their meeting in Budapest, on November 29. A letter containing the statement of the Panel will be sent to the Member States, the Secretary General and the President of the General Assembly of the United Nations. The Panel Members and Sherpas will keep following the statement and engaged with Member States (Water Friends Group, etc.) to proactively support the discussion process through, inter alia, messages, letters and bilateral talks. They will also continue dialogue and collaboration with non-state groups and friends to enlarge networks of actors and supporters relating to new water architecture. Also: Support UN General Assembly resolution on Water Decade as well as support follow-up discussion/action once resolution is adopted by General Assembly.
	 <u>Relative to action 5</u>: Encourage members of the High Level Experts and Leaders Panel on Water and Disasters (HELP) to contribute to the initiatives for water, especially the ones identified in the HLPW Action Plan. It is agreed that the HELP Action Strategy will be developed in line with the water-related HLPW Action Plan/Initiatives.
