Initiate/launch a Challenge inviting the international community to present innovative solutions to provide access to safe and clean drinking water and adequate sanitation to women and girls in the “most remote dwelling” in a village (could be expanded to other categories: refugee camps, rural, peri-urban, access for people with disability etc.)</p> <p>2. Encourage the development and deployment of public awareness and education campaigns for civil society, businesses and government representatives around water quality, sanitation, gender and health.</p> <p>4. Encourage (and commit) to scaling up access to safe and clean drinking water and adequate sanitation especially for women and girls .</p> <p>5. Encourage the recycling of wastewater and ensuring quality prior to human consumption (irrigation or otherwise)</p> <p>6. Encourage the participation of local communities in improving water and sanitation management.</p>
