

Sustainable Development: Review of Progress & Future Pathways

- The relevance, scope and comprehensiveness of the GSDR is of enormous value for the review, follow up and evaluation of SD worldwide.
- It gives a framework for work at a global and country level.
- Yet this completeness and complexity, (even when translating into clearer forms like indicators) is also its greatest challenge.

- To help bridge the gap between the “fundamental complexity” of SD and a “practical simplicity for action”: future GSDR could focus on “types” of issues and types of good practices that can be approached more like a “toolbox”.
- To collaborate with policy makers it could be also be useful to structure priorities according to issue “types”, identify and highlight drivers and critical issues, while not losing the complexity and density of analysis.
