


Graph Key-

II. By Activity Coverage




Activities that received less than 1% of VCs-

Trade of Edible and Non-Edible Sea Food Products, Oil and Gas, Sea Water Desalination and Shipbuilding were addressed by 2 VCs each.

For instance, 234 out of 369, or 63% VCs addressed activity Sustainable Fisheries in its implementation.
