






Progress


The statistical advancement of the ambitious 2030 Agenda has been noteworthy

The patchy progress has been mainly due to: Technical capabilities & complexity

Some national statistical systems (NSS) lack the capacity to comply with the demands of the SDG indicator framework


Technical difficulties and complexity around tier 2 and 3 indicators
