Executive Summary

The II São Paulo State Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) Monitoring Report highlights the government's level of commitment to the implementation of the 2030 Agenda in the São Paulo territory in its "2030 Agenda Implementation History," "Work Methodology," and "Conclusion." This report was prepared with the participation of all members of the State SDG Commission, comprising, approximately 30 government institutions. Through the Program Reports from the various government areas and their interfaces with the Planning instruments (i.e. the PPA and Targets Program), the report presents the government programs prioritized by the São Paulo State Commission in dialogue with the 17 SDGs and many of the 169 targets in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic, which started in 2020.

The II São Paulo State Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) Monitoring Report (*II Voluntary Local Review*) was prepared by the State SDG Commission. The document presents some of the main government programs, linking them to the Multi-Year Plan (PPA) – an important planning instrument for the state – and to the SDGs and their global goals.

This report also represents progress over the years in the dissemination, awareness, and engagement of government agents across areas of activity. It demonstrates, therefore, the São Paulo government's commitment to accelerating the SDGs, in the Decade of Action, which brings countries, states, and municipalities closer together in the struggle for a better world by 2030.
