<p><i>The activity is being proceeded under the project Policy coherence for sustainable development (Improving strategic planning to meet objectives sustainability) funded by National Recovery Plan. The project is taking place from 2023 to 2026 and there are ongoing activities to achieve its objectives including enhancing effectiveness of the strategic planning to delivers on the SDGs in public administration. Those activities included mapping strategies for policy coherence for sustainable development which has been completed, then carrying an analysis of content and process conditions for aligning the objectives of the Czech Republic 2030 with the sustainability of public finances. The report assessing the existing strategies will be presented to the government by the end of the year 2025.</i></p>

<p><i>This commitment is also a part of the previously mentioned NRP project. The public tender for the dataset management system (DSMS) is in the process according to the schedule. The development of the information system itself is now underway. DSMS should be done in December 2025. This activity is managed by Czech Environmental Information Agency (CENIA) with coordination of Czech Statistical Office.</i></p>

Brief description of steps taken on implementation, progress made and/or lessons learned:	
Czech Republic has issued two installments to the Green Climate Fund. The recent one in the amount of USD 1,000,000 was issued in April 2025 and the next payment will be proceeded next year.	

3. If your government is presenting a Voluntary National Review (VNR) at the 2025 HLPF, **how have your announced national commitments, including your policies on leaving no one behind (LNoB) if any, been incorporated or otherwise contributed to your country’s national review processes?**

All voluntary national commitments from the years 2019 and 2023 are included in the VNR 2025, particularly in the chapter on Ownership of the SDGs and VNR. The commitments are accompanied by the marks and comments indicating if the commitments were fulfilled or if the efforts are still ongoing.

Leaving no one behind makes up an individual chapter in the VNR report. It was worked out in cooperation with the Office of the Government, the authority responsible for human rights, equality and inclusion. The chapter focuses on protecting rights and preventing discrimination, vulnerable children and social entrepreneurship.
