Over the course of the past months since September 2023, Germany engaged via the Council of the EU and its various formations in fostering the 2030 Agenda in various fields, calling for an accelerated implementation and promoting policy coherence.

As a result, GER together with the member states of the EU submitted through the Council a number of legislative acts, from which the most important ones are listed below:

- European Council Conclusions (26th/27th October) referring to COP28
- Council Conclusions on "Developing the 2030 Agenda to reach the goals: Accelerating the localization of the SDGs" 11/27/2023
- Council Conclusions (Foreign Affairs Council) on Green Diplomacy 03/18/2024
- Artificial Intelligence Act (Regulation by the European Parliament and the Council) 05/14/2024

Additionally, within the Council Working Party on the 2030 Agenda, GER is advocating for a strategic, comprehensive approach to implement the 2030 Agenda and for more policy coherence within the EU.
